Alvin Crawford (Appellant) appealed to the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) from a December 2, 2011, decision of the Rocky Mountain Regional Director (Regional Director), Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA), upholding an April 28, 2011, decision by BIA's Blackfeet Agency Superintendent to approve the renewal of an easement to ConocoPhillips Pipeline Company across Blackfeet Allotment No. 1760, in which Appellant owns an interest. On December 26, 2013, the Board received from Appellant an unopposed motion to dismiss his appeal with prejudice. Appellant states that all matters relating to his appeal have been resolved by an agreement of the parties. The Board appreciates the parties' efforts to resolve the dispute and grants the motion.¹

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, the Board dismisses the appeal with prejudice.
