The Mendocino County Department of Transportation (Appellant) appealed to the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) from an October 31, 2013, decision of the Pacific Regional Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs, to accept into trust for the Coyote Valley Band of Pomo Indians a 6-acre parcel of land and easement in Mendocino County, California. On January 13, 2014, the Board received a letter from Appellant withdrawing its appeal.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, the Board docketed but dismisses this appeal.
