The Spokane Tribe of Indians (Tribe) appealed to the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) from a July 22, 2013, decision (Decision) of the Northwest Regional Director (Regional Director), Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA). The Decision vacated a December 5, 2012, decision by BIA's Spokane Agency Superintendent to approve the Tribe's cancellation of a homesite lease to Edward Flory, for a 2.5-acre portion of Spokane Tribal Tract No. 102-T1001, on the ground that Flory had died.

On April 18, 2014, the Board received from the Tribe a motion to voluntarily dismiss the appeal.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, the Board dismisses this appeal.
