(Appellant) appealed to the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) from an October 22, 2014, decision of the Acting Southwest Regional Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs, which denied Appellant's request for payment for legal services as court-appointed counsel for Patricia J. Cooyate in an involuntary Indian child custody proceeding in La Plata County (Colorado) District Court (District Court Case No. 2013-DR-30018). *See* 25 C.F.R. § 23.13.

On March 10, 2015, the Board received from Appellant a Notice of Withdrawal of Appeal.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, the Board dismisses the appeal.
