Sean Martin J. Schoolcraft and Patricia A. Schoolcraft-Patencio (Appellants) appealed to the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) from a July 15, 2013, decision (Decision) of the Pacific Regional Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA), declining a request from Appellants for BIA to cancel Lease No. PSL-83, with Seattle City Center's Royal Springs Associates, LLC. The leased premises are on Agua Caliente Allotment No. PS-20A, in Palm Springs, California.

On March 16, 2015, the Board received from Appellants a motion, a copy of which previously was sent by facsimile to the Board, to dismiss their appeal with prejudice. Appellants state that an agreement has been reached among the parties. The Board appreciates the parties' successful settlement efforts and grants the motion.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, the Board dismisses the appeal.
