Curtis Temple (Appellant) appealed to the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) from an August 16, 2013, decision of the Great Plains Regional Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs, denying Appellant’s appeal concerning the allocation of grazing privileges for Range Units 169 and 501 on the Pine Ridge Reservation, which were allocated to Donald “Duke” Buffington.

On May 8, 2015, the Board received from Appellant a motion to voluntarily dismiss the appeal.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, the Board dismisses the appeal.
