Joni Curtis (Appellant) appealed to the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) from an Order Denying Petition for Rehearing (Order Denying Rehearing) entered on January 26, 2015, by Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Richard L. Reeh in the estate of Appellant's mother, Jennie Curtis (Decedent), deceased Cheyenne & Arapaho Indian, Probate No. P000119822IP. The Order Denying Rehearing let stand the ALJ's December 17, 2014, Order Determining Heirs, Approving Will and Decreeing Distribution, which, as relevant to the petition for rehearing, determined that David Curtis and Viola Curtis are entitled to receive a share of Decedent's trust estate as adoptive grandchildren.

On May 11, 2015, the Board received from Appellant a letter withdrawing her appeal.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, the Board docketed but dismisses the appeal.
