Ann Goss (Appellant) appealed to the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) from a May 6, 2015, decision of the Rocky Mountain Regional Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA), overturning a decision of BIA’s Blackfeet Agency Superintendent to approve modifications to certain oil and gas leases with Anschutz Exploration Corporation (AEC) for allotted lands on the Blackfeet Reservation. Appellant owns an interest in two tracts affected by the decision.

On October 30, 2015, the Board received from Appellant a motion to dismiss her appeal with prejudice, based on an agreement reached between Appellant and AEC to settle the dispute. The Board appreciates the parties’ successful settlement efforts.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, the Board dismisses the appeal.
