In these consolidated appeals, Protect the Peninsula's Future (Appellant) appealed to the Board of Indian Appeals (Board) from two decisions dated March 27, 2015, and April 29, 2015, respectively, of the Northwest Regional Director¹, Bureau of Indian Affairs, to accept land in trust for the Jamestown S'Klallam Tribe (Tribe) in Washington State. The first decision is to accept in trust approximately 109.877 acres of land known as the Blyn Basin I Properties. The second decision is to accept in trust approximately 26.756 acres of land known as the Galvin 1 and 2 Parcels.

On June 30, 2016, the Board received from counsel for Appellant a motion to withdraw its appeals based on a stipulation of the parties and the Tribe as amicus. Appellant requests that the Board dismiss the appeals with prejudice. The Board appreciates the parties' successful settlement efforts and grants the request.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Indian Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, the Board dismisses the appeals.
