ORDER

Appellant appealed from a May 7, 2014, decision issued by the Bureau of Safety and Environmental Enforcement (BSEE). BSEE required appellant to agree to certain terms and conditions before the agency would approve appellant's request to defer production of hydrocarbons on several of its offshore oil and gas leases. By Order dated June 22, 2015, the Board suspended the above-captioned appeal so the parties could engage in settlement discussions.

On March 24, 2016, appellant filed with the Board a Consent Motion to Withdraw Appeal. Appellant states the parties successfully resolved their dispute relating to this matter and therefore appellant moves to withdraw the appeal.

Accordingly, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Land Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, we grant appellant's Consent Motion to Withdraw Appeal and dismiss the appeal from our docket.
