ORDER

Appellant appealed from a May 21, 2015, Final Decision issued by the Bureau of Safety and Environmental Enforcement (BSEE). In its Final Decision, BSEE assessed against appellant civil penalties in the amount of \$990,000.00. The penalties stemmed from two regulatory violations that the agency qualified as a threat of harm or damage to life, property, and the environment.

On March 25, 2016, counsel for BSEE filed with the Board an Unopposed Motion to Remand. BSEE states the agency wishes to reconsider its Final Decision and requests the Board to remand the matter back to the agency for further review. Counsel represents that appellant has no objection to BSEE's request for remand.

Accordingly, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Land Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, we grant BSEE's Unopposed Motion to Remand, remand the matter back to the agency for further review, and dismiss the appeal from our docket.
