ORDER

Appellant has appealed from, and petitioned to stay the effect of, a November 19, 2015, Notice of Final Decision issued by the Vale District Office (Oregon), Bureau of Land Management (BLM). In its Decision, BLM approved the immediate implementation of vegetation treatments listed in the agency's Lime Hill Fire Emergency Stabilization Plan. To date, the Board has not ruled on appellant's stay petition.

On January 7, 2016, counsel for BLM requested the Board to vacate and remand the Decision at issue in this appeal. Counsel states that, following an internal review, the agency wishes to reconsider the Decision. Counsel indicates that appellant does not oppose the request.

Based on counsel's representations, the request is granted. 43 C.F.R. § 4.407(c).

Accordingly, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Land Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, BLM's request to vacate and remand the Final Decision is granted and the appeal is dismissed.
