ORDER

Appellant appealed from a February 24, 2016, decision issued by the Bureau of Land Management's (BLM) Arizona State Office. BLM declared appellant's mining claim, AMC426762, forfeited because appellant did not amend the claim within the 30-day timeframe allowed.

On April 12, 2016, BLM transmitted appellant's notice of appeal to the Board, along with a Request for Remand. BLM states that it did not consider certain record evidence before issuing the decision on appeal. BLM seeks a remand of the matter so it can issue a decision that comports with the entire record. Based on its representations, we grant BLM's Request. *See* 43 C.F.R. § 4.407(c).

Accordingly, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Land Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior, 43 C.F.R. § 4.1, we remand the case back to BLM for further review and dismiss the matter from our docket.
