ORDER

Appellant has appealed from an April 6, 2016, decision issued by the Prineville District (Oregon), Bureau of Land Management (BLM). In the decision, BLM denied Appellant's application for a right-of-way over public lands because of the company's debarment.

BLM recently filed with the Board a Motion for Remand (Motion). Therein, BLM explains that the agency would like to reevaluate Appellant's application for a right-of-way. BLM moves the Board to remand the matter back to the agency so that it can withdraw its April 6, 2016, decision.

Based on BLM's representations, we grant the agency's Motion.¹ The matter is remanded to the agency for further review.
