ORDER

Appellant has appealed from a March 24, 2016, Notification of Incident of Non-Compliance (INC) issued by the Bureau of Ocean Energy Management (BOEM). BOEM issued the INC to appellant for not providing supplemental financial assurance for three Federal offshore right-of-way grants.

Counsel for appellant recently filed with the Board a Motion to Dismiss (Motion). In their Motion, counsel indicates that appellant has provided the necessary supplemental bonds and therefore no longer wishes to pursue its appeal. Based on counsel's representation, we grant the Motion.¹

Accordingly, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Land Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior,² appellant's Motion is granted and the matter is dismissed from the Board's docket.
