ORDER

Appellant has appealed from a May 6, 2016, Incident of Noncompliance (INC) issued by the Bureau of Safety and Environmental Enforcement (BSEE). BSEE issued to appellant the INC after determining that the catalytic heaters on appellant's offshore oil and gas production facility, Federal lease OCS-G 30206, Grand Isle Block 115, Facility A, were installed in the incorrect hazardous area classification.

Counsel for BSEE has filed with the Board an Unopposed Motion for Remand (Motion). Counsel states that the agency wishes to reconsider its INC and therefore requests the Board to remand the matter back to BSEE for further review. Counsel represents that appellant does not oppose the Motion. Based on counsel's representations, we grant the Motion.¹

Accordingly, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Land Appeals by the Secretary of the Interior,² we set aside BSEE's INC and remand the matter back to the agency for further review.
