

IBLA 72-322

Decided May 10, 1972

Appeal from a decision (NM 10641) by the New Mexico state office, Bureau of Land Management, requiring payment of the appraised price for conveyance of a small tract.

Dismissed.

An appeal to the Board of Land Appeals will be dismissed when the appellant withdraws the appeal.

By a letter of April 7, 1972, Mr. Rowland, by his attorney, withdrew his appeal concerning his protest to the appraised price for a small tract and indicated his willingness to accept the appraised price. The record shows that Mr. Rowland has already tendered the full purchase price.

Therefore, pursuant to the authority delegated to the Board of Land Appeals (211 DM 13.5; 35 F. R. 12081) the appeal is dismissed and the case remanded to the Bureau of Land Management for appropriate action.
