This is an appeal from an October 16, 1991, decision of the Acting Albuquerque Area Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs, conditionally recognizing an interim tribal council for the Pueblo of San Ildefonso.

Appellants state that events subsequent to the filing of their notice of appeal have rendered the issues in this appeal academic and of no further consequence to them. They therefore seek dismissal of the appeal with prejudice.
