Appellants Lydia Landt, Mary Lekanoff, Peter Lekanoff, Vincent Lekanoff, Constantine Lekanoff, Lorraine Swinney, Helen Lekanoff, and Michael Lekanoff, appealed from an August 4, 2004, decision of the Alaska Regional Director, Bureau of Indian Affairs concerning a rental rate adjustment for BIA Lease No. 82-2, effective October 1, 2001. Offshore Systems, Inc. is the lessee.

On September 26, 2005, the Board received a Notice of Dismissal By Stipulation from the parties, dated September 21, 2005, stating that “[t]he parties have settled their disagreement and agree that this case should be dismissed.”
